# 04. Stone/ Solid Surface

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Stone selections will be designated by your designer. There are many choices including natural stone (such as marble and granite), or manufactured stone (quartz and quartzite). There are pros and cons to each, and a recommendation by a professional according to use, location, wear etc. is suggested.

The stone industry is divided into stone suppliers and stone fabricators. It is critical to ask a supplier if they can fabricate their stone - you will find most companies don't do both. Additionally, when transporting stone, it is always advisable to ask about insurance. Below we have listed stone suppliers and fabricators we know and trust. It is advisable to call ahead and make an appointment before visiting these locations. The sales representative will want to show you around the stone yard or help point you in the right direction.

# 06. Paint & Wallcovering

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Paint is used in every room of your home and it's important that we know the brand and color you're wanting to use. We prefer using Sherwin Williams and have included an allowance for this paint in your proposal. Selections for paint need to be made for walls, ceilings, trim, and more.

A lot of people ask about the difference between paint and stain. The main difference between the two is that paint lies on the surface of the item being painted, whereas stain is absorbed into it. If you have a wood accent wall, raw wood doors, etc., we will need to know if these will be painted or stained and selections for both.

Any Sherwin Williams location is a suitable place to start when choosing paint and stain colors.

# 07. Flooring

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There's a wide variety of options when it comes to flooring. You can choose from tile, carpet, hardwood, engineered hardwood, or LVT. Most of the time, if you're doing an addition to your home, you will want to match your existing flooring found in the adjacent space. Our sales manager most likely already asked you this during one of their initial site visits. If this is the case, we can handle the ordering of material to match.

If you have selected hardwood floors for your addition, you will need to decide what finish you'd like. We recommend refinishing the adjacent space if not the whole home to match. For any other area of the home, you will need to decide what type of flooring you would like to use. Below is a list of Jasper recommended flooring stores to shop. They can help you with questions about staining, durability, and more.

Don't hesitate to reach out to our project manager, sales manager, or your designer/architect about this selection. Remember, there is an allowance included in your proposal for this item!

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Whether you're renovating an existing space or completing an addition, you'll want your doors to match throughout your home. # 09. Vanities

# 10. Glass

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The glass selection includes your shower doors, mirrors, and occasionally backsplash or other custom features. Usually, your architect or designer has specified the style of door for your shower. Please have your designer send drawings to your project manager so they can schedule a fabricator for templating.

Also included in this selection is the hardware needed for glass i.e., handle for shower door, door slider, hinges etc. We recommend matching this hardware to the rest of the hardware in your bathroom, but this is your decision. Please refer to the hardware section of this packet.

# 11. Fireplace
